

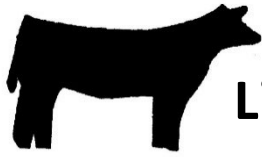
Porter County 4-H Lisa Bloom Memorial Beef Scholarship



This scholarship is dedicated to the memory of Lisa Ann Bloom, daughter of Don and Carol Bloom. Lisa was a 10-year Porter County 4-H member, a 1995 graduate of Chesterton High School, and a graduate of Ivy Tech Community College. Lisa loved participating in the Porter County 4-H Beef project with her Angus cattle. As an active participant in the Beef Project, Lisa took advantage of every opportunity to get involved, learn, and help other 4-Hers. As a 4-H alumna, she continued her involvement with the Beef project; Lisa took great joy in being a mentor and helping beginning members learn about beef animals, fitting, and showmanship. Lisa passed away in August 2007 at the age of 30 and is greatly missed by those whose lives she touched.

General Terms & Conditions:

1. Applicants must have graduated from high school this year and must have been accepted to an institution of higher learning (i.e., college, university, trade school)
2. Applicants must complete the scholarship application.
3. All applicants must be active Porter County 4-H Beef members in good standing and have completed at least 5 years in the Beef project.
4. Financial need shall not be used as a criterion in selecting recipient(s).
5. Money may be requested upon completion of one term of study (e.g., one semester). Proof of completion must be submitted to the Extension Office in the form of grade transcript or completion certificate. Additionally, proof of re-enrollment for the next semester must be submitted to the Extension Office (a copy of the student's statement of class schedule is the most common form used). Scholarship must be claimed by April 15th of the following year.
6. Selection of the awards shall be made by the Porter County 4-H Beef Committee. Representatives of the Don & Carol Bloom Family and the 4-H Youth Development Extension Educator will assist in the selection of Lisa Bloom Memorial Beef Scholarship recipients. Parents of applicants will not serve on the selection committee.
7. Application is due in the Extension Office along with the Beef Fair Entry (Stall) Form by June 27th. Scholarship will be presented at the 4-H Beef Show at the Porter County Fair.
