This award is dedicated to the memory of Tom and Bonnie Hannon.

Tom was a 10- year 4-H swine member and guided each of his four children through 10 years in the swine project in Porter County. Tom served over 30 years as a member of the Porter County Swine Committee, weighing pigs through most of those years. Bonnie was your typical 4H Mom, attending all the livestock shows no matter what day, or what year. The greatest days of her life were visiting with people during the Porter County Fair.

The highlight of Tom and Bonnie's summer was being at the fair, helping and supporting young people with their projects. Tom passed away in May of 2014 and Bonnie in January of 2020. This award will be given annually in their memory.
